- Recommendation letters

JOHN HERTLE VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000.00)

Application requirements and criteria for selection:

- Agricultural, Vocational, or Technical major as a full-time student
- This scholarship assists high school students who are interested in attending a particular Agricultural, Vocational, or Technical program. The application process includes a minimum of 2 letters of recommendation. Selection is made in the spring for fall programs.
