Els Blom, our Past President and member since 1994, was proud enough of the Netherlands Women's Soccer Euro 2017 win over Denmark, she happily rang the bell!



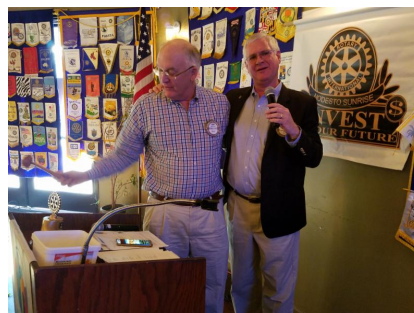
Neal Groesbeck,
